This Adult Non-Check Tournament will be held at the Pop Whalen Ice & Arts Center located at 390 Pine Hill Road, Wolfeboro, NH 03894.

Games will be in a round robin format Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Semi-finals, if necessary, will be Saturday evening and the finals will be held Sunday.

No schedule requests will be accepted We will do our best to give a player-friendly schedule based on travel.

ENTRY FEE, ROSTERS & PRIZING INFORMATION

In order for any division to take place, 4 fully paid teams must be registered prior to February 15th, 2024

All players must be over 18 years of age.

Tournament cost is \$900 per team. To secure your spot in the tournament, a non-refundable deposit of \$250 is due at time of registration. Full payment is due by March 1, 2024.

- Rosters are due by March 1, 2024

Tournament Rules

RULES: USA Hockey rules are in effect except for the modifications listed below. Calls by On-Ice Officials will not be overturned by directors. All decisions by tournament directors are final. The complaint department operates like SAU-49.

- All players are encouraged to follow USA Hockey equipment requirements and recommendations.
- This is a non-checking event. Body checking is NOT permitted.
- Slap shots are NOT permitted.
- The tag-up rule will be used for off-sides.
- Fighting **WILL NOT** be tolerated. Any players involved in a fight as deemed by the game officials will receive an automatic expulsion from the tournament and future Hockey tournaments.
- Major penalties such as spearing or butt-ending could result in expulsion from the tournament.
- Each team is allowed one time out per game.
- All teams must have home (light) and away (dark) jerseys.
- All jerseys must be numbered.
- Any team who willingly forfeits a game will not be eligible for semi-final or final games in the event, and may face future ineligibility at future hockey tournaments.
- **Illegal players and teams:**

- Male Players may only play on one team in the tournament. Male Players cannot play for multiple teams in multiple divisions. Exceptions may be made for goaltenders in extenuating circumstances.
- Game officials (referees) working games in the tournament may play for any team at any level registered in the tournament provided it does not negatively impact other games.

Game Format

GAME TIME RULES

PERIODS

(3) 12 Minute Periods (Stopped Time)

No overtime in regular games. * Special Overtime rules below

PENALTIES

MINOR = 1.5 Mins **MAJOR** = 5 Mins **MISC.** = 10 Mins

NOTE: If the score difference is (6) goals or more at any time during the third period, the clock goes to running time. |

WARM-UPS: Five (5) minutes. The warm-up clock starts after the Zamboni has left the ice and you have been "buzzed" onto the ice. No one is allowed on the ice before the Zamboni doors are closed

INVOLVE THE LADIES: (2) Female players must be on the ice at all times during play. The goalie does NOT count as a 2nd female player for this. *See shoot out exception to this rule Only (2) Male goals will count per period. This is to keep everyone involved. You are not being scouted today.

ICE RESURFACING: The ice will be cleaned before each game. There is no resurface after the warm-up or between periods. *Note the special rules for Overtime below.

OVERTIME:

All ROUND ROBIN Games will be played to a conclusion as follows:

- At the end of the third period, the teams take a two (2) minute rest period.
- Teams do NOT switch ends at any time during the overtime period.

- A five (5) minute, stop time, 3 on 3, "sudden death" period will be played. (1) Female player must be on the ice at all times.
- Penalty(s) will carry over into the overtime and/or shoot out.
- If neither team scores, there will be a three (3) player shootout format. Visitor shoots first. (1) Female player must be as a shooter.
- If no winner is determined, then a "sudden death shootout" will be held with the visiting team shooting first, and each team getting a shot, until there is a winner.
- Three different players are required for first shootout. The same three players can be used during the "sudden death shootout", only one time each. Then continue through the roster.

All SEMI-FINAL & CHAMPIONSHIP Games will be played to a conclusion as follows:

- At the end of the third period, the teams take a two (2) minute rest period.
- Teams do NOT switch ends at any time during the overtime period.
- 15 minute, 'sudden death' overtime periods will be played until a team scores.

TIMEOUTS: No timeouts are allowed to keep game times on schedule.

Tie Breakers

TIE BREAKER RULES TO DETERMINE STANDINGS POSITIONS

THE STANDINGS SHALL BE DETERMINED UTILIZING THE FOLLOWING POINT SYSTEM: IF TWO OR MORE TEAMS HAVE AN EQUAL NUMBER OF POINTS, THE STANDINGS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY: *THE FORMULAS SHALL BE APPLIED IN ORDER UNTIL ONE FORMULA BREAKS THE TIE FOR A POSITION BETWEEN ALL OF THE TEAMS AT THE SAME TIME **"Head to Head" Win/Loss will be used 1st as a tie breaker. If this doesn't settle it the following will be used...**

2nd - Goals Against **3rd** - Least Penalty Minutes **4th** - Goals For **Last**- Coin Flip

I understand that I am Participating in Adult Co-Ed Ice Hockey and am doing such voluntarily, knowingly and freely given the nature of the Program and understand that participation in Ice Hockey, and the activities associated with it, is a potentially hazardous activity. I understand that Ice Hockey involves a risk of serious injury and that I am voluntarily participating in this Ice Hockey that may involve the use of equipment and machinery, interactions with other players or participants and customary game practices with knowledge of the risks involved. I hereby agree to expressly assume and accept any and all risks, whether known or unknown, minor or serious, that may arise out of my participation.

2. I do hereby further declare that I am physically sound and suffering from no condition, impairment, disease, infirmity or other illness that would prevent participation in this Program and associated activities or the use of equipment or machinery associated with such. I also acknowledge that it has been recommended that I consult with a physician prior to partaking in Ice Hockey, physical activity and use of sports equipment. I acknowledge I have either had a physical examination and been given a physician's permission to participate, or that I have decided to participate without the approval of a physician and do hereby assume all responsibility and risks for my involvement in Ice Hockey.

3. Medical Emergencies: In the event of a medical emergency during participation, reasonable efforts will be made to call any emergency contact number known. However, such effort shall not prevent the rendering of emergency care deemed to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Participant. I grant permission to the Program Representative or their designee to furnish and arrange any emergency hospital or medical care that I might require in the event of a sickness, injury or accident.

4. Personal Property: I understand the Friends of Kingswood Hockey, any of its Departments and its officers, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, staff, coaches, officials, supervisors, sponsors, other participants and assigns will not be liable for damage, theft, loss or other issues with personal belongings, valuables or electronic devices brought to the Program or at locations being utilized I understand that if I bring any personal belongings, electronic devices, money or other items of value, I do so at my own risk.

5. Conduct and Regulations: I agree to abide by and observe all customary rules, regulations and terms of play for participation in this sporting activity and Program, demonstrate good sportsmanlike conduct at all times and agree to abide by any posted rules and regulations in any facility or location of the Program.

6. I understand that if I am involved in a Friends of Kingswood Hockey sport or program that involves the use of Town owned equipment and/or uniforms, any Town owned equipment and/or uniforms borrowed and/or utilized during the event remains the property of the Town of Wolfeboro and must be returned at the end of the event. I further understand that if all equipment and uniform pieces are not returned, the cost of the replacement of such is my responsibility and registration for future programs will be suspended until return is complete.

7. RELEASE OF LIABILITY: I hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless the Friends of Kingswood Hockey, any of its Departments and its officers, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, staff, coaches, officials, supervisors, sponsors, other participants and assigns harmless and indemnify them from and against any liability, claims, judgments or expenses that may arise out of or from participation in the Program, including but not limited to, injury, accidents, loss of property, death, disability, paralysis, sickness or exposure to other illnesses, whether or not such is caused by negligence of the Town of Wolfeboro, any of its Departments and its officers, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, staff, coaches, officials, supervisors, sponsors, other participants and assigns.

8. I understand that I may be photographed during participation and that the photos may be used for promotional purposes, newspaper releases or placed on the Friends of Kingswood Hockey public website.

9. This Agreement and Release of Liability shall remain in effect from initial sign-up for programming and for all participation in any activities and programs of the Friends of Kingswood Hockey in the current year, or the use of its facilities or equipment as part of its programming, without the need for the entry into a new Agreement and Release of Liability.
